## Carl Lee "Coach" Edwards (1936-2009)

Carl "Coach" Lee Edwards, 72, retired teacher, golf coach, and athletic director, passed away Thursday, July 9, 2009. He was under the care of Sterling Commons Care Facility in Victorville.
