# Mr. Albert Ramos

Albert was born and raised in Barstow, CA, graduated from Barstow High in 1970, and continued his schooling at Barstow College later graduating with his BS in 1972.

In 1974, Albert volunteered as a Reserve Deputy with the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department. July 4, 1977 he was accepted to the SBSB academy, graduated in September 1977, and was then assigned to the Barstow Sheriff's Station on March 20, 1978.
