KENNETH P. SCHLEUSNER Kenneth Paul Schleusner passed into the loving arms of his Lord and Savior on Saturday, March 24, 2012 following a six-month long battle with cancer. He was born on the family homestead near White- water, Montana on November 29, 1919. He served his country in [WWII](#) as a member of the 15th Army Air Corps in North Africa and Italy, attaining the rank of Captain. Returning home he completed college, obtained a teaching credential, and married Doris, his wife of almost 59 years on June 9, 1952. They first lived in northern

California where Ken taught high school in Fort Jones, later moving to the High Desert - first Hinkley, and then to Apple Valley in 1965 where they remained for 45 years. Ken taught industrial arts and metal shop at Barstow High School until he retired in 1976. He was preceded in death by his wife Doris, and leaves behind their son Douglas and his wife Sandra and their children Eric and Katherine; son Gregory and his wife Ann Marie and their children Heidi, Amy, James, Maggie, and Ruth; and siblings Clifford Schleusner, Idelia Vaupel, and Hattie Engstrand. A graveside service will be held at 11:00 a.m., Friday, March 30 at Sunset Hills Memorial Park, 24000 Waalew Rd, Apple Valley, CA. His family invites Ken's friends to the service.
