He worked as a bar manager from 1973 to 1977 in Merced; as head bartender from 1977 to 1979 at Golden Horne in Long Beach, Calif.; bartender at Gino's in Albuquerque, N.M. from 1980 to 1982; worked at the NCO Club as a manager at the Barstow Marine Base from 1983 to 1984; administrative specialist records at Reese Air Force Base in Lubbock, Texas from 1984 to 1985 and again at Kirtland Air Force Base in Albuquerque, N.M. from 1985 to 1988; he trained horses at Thompson Racing Stables in Benton, Louisiana from 1988 to 1990; administrative specialist records at Air Force Test Range in Tonapah, Nevada from 1990 to 1993; a security guard at The Orleans in Las Vegas, Nev. from 1994 to 1999; a courier for Sunrise Hospital in Las Vegas, Nev., from 2001 to 2006; and was retired (disabled) from 2006 to 2013 in Las Vegas, Nev. He is survived by his mother, Chris; sister, Veronica; uncles, Gilbert and Ralph; and aunt, Reina. Rosary will be at 9 a.m. with Funeral Mass at 10 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church on March 7, 2013.
