

Franklin E. Dolph (1918 – 2000)

Frank Dolph, 81, of Savannah, Ga., died Tuesday, Oct. 3, 2000. Born on Nov. 22, 1918 in Norfolk, Va., Dolph was a 1937 graduate of Barstow High School and lived in Barstow for 20 years. He worked for the Santa Fe Railroad, Bank of America in Barstow and Lloyds of London Bank Beaumont.
