David Starr Jordan Jr., 58, died Saturday, June 24, 2006, at Flagstaff Medical Center. He was born Oct. 6, 1947, in Loma Linda, Calif., and grew up in Barstow, Calif.

Mr. Jordan spent his early years working as a mechanic in Needles, Calif., Yuma, Williams and Flagstaff. In 1995, he opened Seven Day Auto in east Flagstaff. He also founded and managed Starr Tire. Customers will remember Mr. Jordan as a great mechanic and an honest and trustworthy businessman.
