Leonard R. "Joe" Myers, 79, passed away Dec. 28, 2006, in Vista following a long illness. Joe was born Nov. 9, 1927 in Huntington Park, and lived in Vista during his last 12 years. He was a long-time resident and owner of two propane businesses in Barstow, where he was active in several community organizations and a volunteer fireman.
